He possesses a Doctorate in Veterinary Medicine and Bachelor of Science degree in Veterinary Science from Colorado State University.

Lt. Col. Gold is also a Diplomate of the American College of Laboratory Animal Medicine, having completed the four-year US Army Laboratory Animal Residency Program. He holds a faculty appointment to the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences in the Department of Biometrics and Preventive Medicine, and has completed the following military schools: Army Basic Training, the Field Medical Specialist Advanced Individual Training, Veterinary Corps Officers' Orientation Course, the Army Medical Department Officers Advanced Course, CAS3, Command and General Staff College, and the US Army War College; earning both a Military Education Level 1 rating and a Masters of Strategic Studies degree.
