100th Medical Detachment (VS HQ)

The 100th Medical Detachment is a subordinate command of V Corps and 30th Medical Brigade and provides command and control to five [Table of Organization and Equipment](#) and three [Table of Distribution and Allowances](#) veterinary detachments. The unit builds and sustains military readiness by providing high quality veterinary support in areas of food safety, food quality assurance and animal medicine for all DoD installations and operations located within the United States European Command.



MEDFLAG 2000-02 - From 14 to 29 September 2000 veterinary personnel from the 100th Med Det led a Combined and Joint Medical Task Force to Mauritania, West Africa to conduct MEDFLAG 2000-02. The CJMTF was comprised of US Navy, Air Force, and Army personnel as well as NATO military members from Great Britain, Germany, and Holland. During the ten day exercise more than 700 Mauritanian citizens received ophthalmic and dental care and more than 200 camels from Mauritania's 7th Military Region received veterinary care.



During FY01 the 100th Med Det has participated in Focus Relief I in Nigeria, January; Victory Focus Warfighter at Vilseck, Germany in January; Adventure Express in Turkey, February; Agile Lion in Vicenza, Italy, February; US Embassy in Romania, March; Peace Shield in Ukraine, July; Urgent Victory in March; Blackhawk Down in Morocco, July; Amber Hope in Lithuania in July; SFOR Port Ops in Slovenia, August; Rescuer in Bulgaria in September, and Victory Strike in Poland, September.

During FY02 the 100th Med Det has participated Victory Strike in Poland, October; Adventure Exchange to Turkey, November; Victory Focus Warfighter at Wiesbaden, Germany in January; Atlas Drop in Tunisia in January; Urgent Victory Warfighter at Wiesbaden, March; 21st Med Det (VS)(SM) deployment to Kosovo, March-October; Adventure Express in Norway, February; Avid Recovery in Nigeria, February-April, Cornerstone 02 in Albania, April, and Victory Strike in Poland, September.
