Rota Veterinary Treatment Facility

The Veterinary Treatment Facility (VTF) is located in South-Western Spain the Province of Andalucia.

Bldg. # 1863, Naval Station Rota Spain.

HOURS: Veterinary Treatment Facility: Open Monday - Friday 0830-1600.

CAPABILITIES: General veterinary care including: sick call, minor surgeries, health certificates, routine vaccinations, x-rays, laboratory services.

ACCESS: Active duty, retirees, and their dependents which are seen by appointment only on a first come first serve basis - Monday - Friday from 1300-1530.

REFERRALS: For patients requiring specialty consultation or services beyond the capability of the VTF, patients are referred off-base to local Spanish veterinarians. A list of local vets is available at the VTF and posted on the door for after hours visits.

EMERGENCY CARE: Patients requiring emergency care or urgent care after hours should contact local off-base civilian veterinarians. (A list is available at the VTF and is posted on the door).

FOOD INSPECTION: During duty hours (DSN 727-3236). After duty hours cellular phone (659469320). Assigned Veterinary Food Inspection Personnel provide food Safety and Inspection service on a priority basis.

MISSION: Southern Europe Veterinary Detachment Western Mediterranean Branch's mission is to provide veterinary service support to U.S. Forces activities in Spain and Portugal. This includes support of the U.S. Navy Sixth Fleet operating in the Mediterranean Sea. Food Inspection support to Naval Station Base Activities include: Commissary, Navy Supply, Navy Exchange, MWR, and two Galleys. Additional Food Inspection support is provided to Moron Airbase, Fresh Fruits and Vegetable procurement inspection, antemortem and postmortem poultry inspection, support of two U.S. Embassies in Madrid and Lisbon, and commercial sanitary inspections.

HISTORY: Naval Station Rota was founded as part of a Mutual Defense, and Economic Aid agreement in 1953. Naval Station Rota covers 6000 areas of geographically key terrain used jointly by Spain and the United States.
