Colonel Jones began his Army career when he enlisted in 1969. After completing Basic Training and Military Police Advanced Individual Training he was sent to Vietnam. Following a one-year tour in the Republic of Vietnam, he was stationed at Ft. Leonard Wood and completed his active enlisted service in the fall of 1971 as a Sergeant. He then attended the University of Minnesota obtaining Bachelor of Science and Medical Degrees. He did post graduate training in General Surgery at the University of Missouri then re-entered the Army completing a residency in Orthopaedic Surgery at Tripler Army Medical Center in 1982. He later completed a Fellowship in Surgery of the Hand at the Campbell Clinic and University of Tennessee Medical Center in Memphis and has been certified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery in Orthopaedic Surgery and in the sub-specialty of Hand Surgery. COL Jones holds the "A" proficiency designator in Orthopaedic Surgery and is widely published in his specialty. He is a graduate of the United States Army Command and General Staff College and the Army War College-Department of Health and Human Services Fellowship (Senior Service College Fellowship).

Colonel Jones is currently the Deputy Commander of Europe Regional Medical Command and Deputy USAREUR Surgeon. Recent tours include: Commander, Ireland Army Community Hospital; Chief Medical Officer, TRICARE Management Activity; Deputy Commander for Clinical Services, Madigan Army Medical Center; Chief of Orthopaedics and Director of the Orthopaedic Residency Program at Madigan Army Medical Center and prior to that at Fitzsimons Army Medical Center.

Colonel Jones is a member of the Order of Military Medical Merit and has been awarded the Good Conduct Medal, the Army Achievement Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, the Army Commendation Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Legion of Merit with Oak Leaf Cluster, the Office of the Secretary of Defense Badge, and the Office of the Secretary of Health and Human Services Badge. Other awards include the Joint Meritorious Unit Award, the Army Superior Unit Award, and the Vietnam Gallantry Cross Unit Citation with Palm Device.
