



Colonel Jeffrey B. Clark was born in LaGrange, N.C. He graduated from Davidson College, Davidson, N.C., in 1978 and received his medical degree from East Carolina University in 1984.

Following completion of a residency in Family Practice at Silas B. Hays Army Community Hospital at Fort Ord, Calif., he was assigned to the 543rd General Dispensary, Camp Walter, Taegu, Korea, from 1987 to 1989. During his subsequent assignment at Fort Bragg, N.C., he served as a staff Family Physician at the 1st Corps Support Command Clinic, teaching faculty and Clinic Director of the Womack Army Medical Center Family Practice Residency Program, and Senior Medical Officer of C Company, 307th Medical Battalion, 82nd Airborne Division, during Operation Desert Shield and Desert Storm in the Persian Gulf. Following graduation from Command and General Staff Officer College, Fort Leavenworth, Kan., he served as Division Surgeon, 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, N.C. In July 1997, Colonel Clark completed a two-year Family Practice Faculty Development Fellowship at Madigan Army Medical Center, Fort Lewis, Wash.

Colonel Clark's awards include the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Service Medal (3OLC), the Army Commendation Medal (1OLC), the Army Achievement Medal (1OLC), the Combat Medical Badge, Expert Field Medical Badge, Flight Surgeon Badge, and the Parachutist's Badge.
